**RESOLUTION 6-26**

On motion by **Jason Sarnoski**, seconded by **James Kern III**, the following resolution was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren at a meeting held on January 1, 2026.

**RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC NOTICES TO BE POSTED ON THE  
COUNTY OF WARREN'S INTERNET WEBSITE**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Warren filed an action in New Jersey Superior Court in 2024, which ultimately led to the State Legislature adopting P.L. 2025 Ch. 72, which was signed into law by the Governor, and which provides for New Jersey Counties and other public entities to transition to publishing legal notices online instead of utilizing traditional newspapers or designating official newspapers; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Warren is in the process of complying with P.L. 2025, Ch. 72, such that legal notices will be able to be posted on the County's website.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Warren, as follows:

1. From January 1, 2026 through February 28, 2026, public notices required to be published or advertised by the County of Warren shall be published or advertised either on the Internet Website of the County, or in a physical newspaper published and circulating in Warren County, pursuant to P.L. 2025, Ch. 72. The County Administrator is authorized to determine which method to utilize.
2. Consistent with P.L. 2025, Ch. 72, no later than March 1, 2026, any legal notice required to be published or advertised by the County of Warren shall be published or advertised on the County of Warren's official Internet website, which shall be accessible to the public at no charge. The website shall also contain a hyperlink to legal notices, which shall be conspicuously placed on the website's homepage.
3. Starting on January 1, 2026, and at least twice per month through December 31, 2026, the County of Warren shall provide an advertisement in an online news publication that meets the requirements of subsection b. of section 3 of P.L.2025, c.72 (C.35:3-3) that:


(1) states that the complete text of each legal notice may be obtained or viewed by the public on the official Internet website of the County of Warren; and

(2) provides the hyperlink to the Secretary of State's legal notices hyperlink Internet webpage established pursuant to subsection b. of section 2 of P.L.2025, c.72 (C.35:3-2).

4. The County shall maintain an Internet archive of legal notices that are no longer displayed, as required by law.
5. The County Administrator is authorized to undertake such actions as may be necessary to effectuate this resolution, including but not limited to designating responsibilities among County staff to ensure compliance with this resolution and P.L. 2025, Ch. 72
